

CHAS INDOOR RANGE RULES FOR THE PHOENIX RANGE:

1. The Phoenix Range will be available for CHAS member use on TUESDAY evening from 6:00 PM till close ONLY. (subject to change)
2. Five (5) passes will be available. Only five (5) CHAS Members will be able to shoot at one time.
3. At this time you will be allotted 45 minutes of shooting time, depending on the influx of members.
4. Phoenix passes are held by the CHAS Range official. Passes will be supplies, upon Sign in, and only to CHAS members showing their current and valid CHAS membership card.
5. You will turn in your CHAS card (s) CHAS Range official., and in turn receive the CHAS Phoenix Range card. When you leave, be sure to pick up YOUR card (s) (and not those belonging to another CHAS Member), and turn in the Phoenix Range card.
6. ALL Phoenix Range Rules MUST BE OBEYED. (see Phoenix Range rules below)
7. Holster will not be used or permitted until individual members have been qualified by Phoenix Range personnel.

PHOENIX INDOOR RANGE & GUN SHOP LTD. **GENERAL RANGE RULES & PROCEDURES**

Welcome.

There are NO stupid questions! We encourage you to ask questions about firearms, firearm safety, or range procedures. We want your visit to be a SAFE & enjoyable one.

1. ALL firearms brought onto or into the range are to be in a case.
2. NEVER use any Ammunition unless it is specifically designed for your firearm.
3. NO uncased restricted firearms are to be carried inside this building under any circumstances. (for exceptions see Pistol Rule # 7 & 8)

4. ALL firearms are only to be removed from their case when IN the shooting booth (for exceptions see Pistol Rule # 7 & 8)
5. DO NOT carry a firearm from the safety area to the shooting booth unless it has been proved empty, cased or if permitted, holstered securely. There are to be no uncased restricted firearms outside of the shooting booth. (for exceptions see Pistol Rule # 7 & 8)
6. Muzzles are to be pointed down range at all times, loaded or unloaded.
7. All members are to sign in by swiping their membership cards. All “Day Pass” holders MUST provide identification, fill out waivers & read these Rules.
8. All persons entering the range MUST have a valid range membership, or a day pass. (Shooters & non-shooters alike) Those who wish to view the action can observe in safety at no cost from the lounge area through the glass.
9. If a problem arises out on the range with either firearms or range equipment, please ask our range staff for assistance & DO NOT bring the firearm off the range unless asked to do so.
10. There is to be NO cross firing. DO NOT hang targets in another lane & shoot at them.
11. Please ask our staff to perform any repairs to range equipment when necessary.
For your own safety DO NOT attempt repairs yourself.
12. Please advise our staff of any unsafe shooters or shooting conditions
13. Eye & ear protection is MANDATORY for everyone on the range. If you do not have your own, Phoenix will provide them for you.
14. For health reasons, food & drink are NOT permitted on the range. We also strongly advise the thorough washing of hands prior to leaving the range.
15. There is NO SMOKING anywhere on the premises.
16. “Cease Fire” means to immediately STOP shooting, unload, clear guns, & place the firearm down, with the muzzle pointed down range & then back away from the firearm & out of the booth. This command may be a whistle blast or a verbal command.

17. Juniors, (under the age of 18), must be accompanied on the range by a legal parent or guardian. The adult guardian must be in possession of a valid PAL unless you are accompanied by a range officer.

18. Absolutely NO HORSE PLAY on any range. You will be asked to leave & possibly barred.

19. Persons who appear to be under the influence of any mind altering substances or alcohol will be denied entrance, removed & barred from the premises.

20. Please clean up after you shoot. Sweep unwanted brass out of the booth onto the range & place used targets & empty ammunition boxes in the waste containers provided.

21. There is a maximum of TWO (2) firearms allowed per booth. One firearm may be loaded & in use, & the other is to be unloaded & pointing down range. ONLY ONE (1) firearm is to be fired at a time.

22. All targets are to be made from paper or cardboard, & inserted on the supplied holders only. Targets may not have a human facial characteristic, human silhouette targets are permitted. Empty ammunition boxes, golf balls, pop cans, cell phones etc. are NOT approved as targets on our ranges!

23. NO BLACK POWDER is permitted on any range, at any time.

24. For everyone's safety. Ammunition that fails to fire for any reason, MUST be placed in the WHITE Propane bottles located on both ranges, or turned in at the front desk.
DO NOT THROW THEM DOWN RANGE OR IN THE GARBAGE.

25. Verbal or physical abuse of other customers or staff will NOT be tolerated.

26. Persons damaging or defacing the range & company property, with be asked to leave & could face criminal charges.

27. Our staff have the final say in all range safety matters.

PHOENIX INDOOR RANGE Additional ~ PISTOL RANGE RULES :

1. CASE AND UNCASE YOUR FIREARM IN THE SHOOTING BOOTH ONLY. Leave your case at your feet.

2. NEVER use any Ammunition unless it is specifically designed for your firearm.

3. There is a pistol safety area, located just prior to entering the actual pistol firing range.

ABSOLUTELY NO AMMUNITION HANDLING at ANY TIME in this area. This area is for un-casing firearms into a holster or the re-casing a firearm from a holster, .(& ONLY if approved, see pistol rule # 7 & 8) & safety briefings. This area can also be used for minor gun-smithing. Muzzles are to be pointed toward the brick wall at all times.

4. The muzzle velocity MUST be less than 1,750 feet per second.

5. You MUST STAY in the booth & on the red tile area to shoot. DO NOT advance down range.

6. Firearm handling & shooting, MUST take place within the confines of the RED tiled area of the range ONLY.

7. Rapid fire is permitted ONLY if you are in control & are hitting the target.

8. Holstered firearms ARE allowed on the pistol range, BUT ONLY WITH approval of the management. i.e.: Holders of Black Badge certification, Police, Security Staff, Etc.

9. UNLOADED holstered firearms are NOT allowed in the lounge area, unless FIRST approved by the management. i.e.: Holders of Black Badge certification, Police, Security Staff, Etc. On designated club/league nights

10. NEVER enter the retail area wearing a holstered firearm. Doing so breaks federal law.

11. Handguns must NOT be left unattended, or insecure. Follow proper "Safe Storage" procedures at all times.

12. NO steel shot, steel cored, prohibited ammunition, bird shot or multiple projectile shot, permitted on this range. Any part of your ammo MUST NOT stick to a magnet.

13. Rimfire rifles are allowed on both the pistol & rifle ranges.
14. NO SHOTGUNS are PERMITTED ON THIS RANGE, UNLESS supervised by Phoenix range staff.
15. When retrieving your own spent/fired brass. NO MOVEMENT FORWARD of the firing line is allowed at ANY TIME If you can't reach it safely with a broom, then it will stay out of reach!

PHOENIX INDOOR RANGE Additional ~ RIFLE RANGE RULES:

1. CASE AND UNCASE YOUR FIREARM IN THE SHOOTING BOOTH ONLY. Leave your case at your feet.
2. NEVER use any Ammunition unless it is specifically designed for your firearm.
3. This rifle range was designed to sight in or test the accuracy of ammunition ONLY.. It was NOT designed for RAPID FIRE.
4. There will be NO RAPID FIRE on this range, a distinct pause is required between each shot. (at least 2 seconds)
5. NO bird shot is to be used on this range, ONLY LEAD SLUGS from a shotgun.
6. NO armour piercing, steel jacketed, steel cored, tracer rounds or prohibited ammunition is allowed on this range Mandatory ammunition Inspection is required by Phoenix staff, also there is a magnet located on the rear wall for your convenience.
7. DO NOT chamber, or LOAD the firearm UNLESS the barrel is inserted through the firing ports/slots & pointed down range at the target.
8. ONLY two rifles are permitted outside of a case at a time. All other firearms MUST BE in a CASE. ONLY one rifle at a time can be used in any one booth.
9. All TARGETS are to be made from PAPER or CARDBOARD, & suspended from the target line rope ONLY. Empty ammunition boxes, golf balls, pop cans, cell phones etc. are NOT approved as targets on our ranges!

10. As this rifle range has no target retrieval system, YOU must ASK other users for a "Cease Fire" to go down range to check or replace your targets. While they are down range the ALL firearms MUST be UNLOADED, NOT HANDLED & Will remain in the shooting booth. Unmolested.
11. There will be NO SHOOTING FROM THE PRONE or KNEELING POSITION. You MUST fire through the firing ports/slots in the booth wall ONLY.
